### Day wise Itinerary

Day 1	<b>Arrival</b>
	Welcome to NEW ZEALAND! Upon arrival at Christchurch, meet our representative at airport and transfer to the hotel for check-in.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Christchurch</b> .
	MEALS: Indian Dinner
Day 2	<b>Christchurch → Queenstown</b>
	After breakfast, check out and drive to Queenstown. On the way, see the beautiful <b>Lake Tekapo</b> and <b>Lake Pukaki</b> . We may also get a glimpse of <b>Mt. Cook</b> (subject to weather conditions). Later continue to Queenstown.
	Welcome to <b>Queenstown</b> – Magnificent vistas and majestic mountains dominate this compact alpine resort town and with such an expansive natural physical environment it is not surprising that Queenstown has been described as the Adventure Capital of the World! Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Queenstown</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 3	<b>Queenstown – Skyline Gondola</b>
	After breakfast, start your day by riding Southern Hemisphere's steepest gondola ( <b>Skyline Gondola</b> ) to the top of Bob's Peak. The viewing deck offers sweeping views of the town, Lake Wakatipu, and the Remarkables Mountain Range. After Lunch, drive to <b>Glenorchy</b> . Located 45 minutes from Queenstown, there is a paradise on earth, Glenorchy & the 45-minute drive from Queenstown to Glenorchy is arguably the best in all of New Zealand. Glenorchy is an ideal place for walking & hiking in the mountain ranges and awe-inspiring forests. Surrounded by the Lake Wakatipu and Dart River, enjoy breathtaking landscapes and adventure activities.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Queenstown</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 4	<b>Queenstown – Milford Sound</b>
	After breakfast, leaving from Queenstown in the early morning & make your way towards <b>Te Anau</b> . This two-hour drive along Lake Wakatipu and into southern farmland is absolutely stunning and a perfect introduction for what lies ahead. Carry on your journey towards <b>Milford Sound</b> as you come across many other scenic spots. Admire waterfalls gushing into pools of sparkling water, take in the panoramic views from The Divide and the Hollyford Valley Lookout and take a thrilling walk over a footbridge at The Chasm. Travelling through the Homer Tunnel, a 1.2km tunnel, you're very close to Milford Sound. Once you've reached the Milford Sound wharf, board your cruise on the crystal clear waters of Milford Sound and enjoy an up-close viewing experience of waterfalls, marine wildlife and the almighty Mitre Peak.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Queenstown</b> .

Day 5	<b>Queenstown → Auckland</b>
	After breakfast, check out from Queenstown and proceed to airport to board your flight to Auckland.
	Upon arrival at Auckland, meet our representative at airport and transfer to the hotel for check-in.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Auckland</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 6	<b>Auckland → Waitomo → Rotorua</b>
	After breakfast, check out and proceed to <b>Rotorua</b> . Enroute, discover your moment of magic in the <b>Waitomo Glowworm Caves</b> tour Known as one of New Zealand's best natural attractions, take a boat ride through the glowworm grotto, marvel at thousands of magical glowworms and become part of over 130 years of cultural and natural history. After lunch, continue to Rotorua – known for bubbling mud pools, shooting geysers and natural hot springs, as well as showcasing their fascinating Māori culture. Check in at your hotel in Rotorua after dinner.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Rotorua</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 7	<b>Rotorua – Agrodome → Auckland</b>
	After breakfast, visit one of New Zealand's most unforgettable cultural experiences, <b>Whakarewarewa</b> – The Living Māori Village offers a Jurassic park-like geothermal landscape and a rejuvenating nature-walk for all ages. Enjoy the <b>Māori Cultural Performance show</b> ; Kapa haka – or traditional performing arts – is an integral part of Māori culture. Unique and captivating for the way it combines waiata (song) with haka (dance), kapa haka is both an ancient and a living art form. After lunch, visit the world-renowned <b>Agrodome</b> . Sheep are a common sight as you travel through New Zealand. To get up close to the woolly creatures and learn more about New Zealand's farming industry, visit Rotorua's Agrodome. Here, we see a wool-spinning demonstration, take a farm tour, enjoy an interactive sheep-shearing show, and watch sheep dogs at work. Later proceed back to Auckland.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Auckland</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 8	<b>Auckland → Melbourne</b>
	After breakfast at the hotel, check-out and transfer Christchurch airport for flight to Melbourne.
	Welcome to Melbourne, the Sports capital of Australia. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel ( <i>standard check-in time is 1500 hrs</i> ).
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Melbourne</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 9	<b>Melbourne (City Tour)</b>
	After breakfast, proceed for the <b>orientation city tour of Melbourne</b> – photo stop at the <b>Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG)</b> from outside; drive pass <b>St. Patrick Cathedral, Town hall, Parliament house, Captain Cook cottages</b> and <b>Fitzroy gardens</b> . Later proceed to <b>Phillip Island</b> , to witness the elegant and world's smallest Penguins, that walk to the shores in a parade, a not to miss event.(timing may vary as per season)
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Melbourne</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner





Day 10	<b>Melbourne (Great Ocean Road)</b>
	After breakfast, we drive through one of the world's most beautiful and naturally maintained destinations – <b>The Great Ocean Road</b> . As we drive, get a glance of the 12 Apostles, Shipwreck Coast and Port Campbell National park.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Melbourne</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 11	<b>Melbourne → Albury → Canberra</b>
	After breakfast, check out & drive to Canberra. Enroute visit <b>Albury</b> and later continue to Canberra – The capital of Australia. The site of Canberra was selected for the location of the nation's capital in 1908 as a compromise between rivals Sydney and Melbourne, Australia's two largest cities. Upon arrival, after hot Indian dinner, check in at your hotel.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Canberra</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 12	<b>Canberra</b>
	After breakfast, enjoy <b>orientation city tour of Canberra</b> . Start by visiting <b>Mt Ainslie</b> - paved observation deck with panoramic vistas & information plaques detailing distant landmarks. Then visit <b>New Parliament House, Royal Australian Mint &amp; Australian National University</b> .
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Canberra</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 13	<b>Canberra → Sydney</b>
	After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Today fasten your seat belts and enjoy the Grand Pacific Drive to Sydney.
	Upon arrival, enjoy a photo stop at the world's most iconic landmark – The Sydney Opera House, followed by visit to Bondi beach. Later enjoy the orientation tour covering <b>Harbour Bridge, Eastern suburb</b> and stroll around the <b>Darling Harbour</b> .
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Sydney</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 14	<b>Sydney</b>
	After breakfast, proceed for a day trip to " <b>BLUE MOUNTAIN</b> ". Today we drive via beautiful Katoomba village & experience the Blue Mountain (also known as three sisters) and discover Spectacular views of dense eucalyptus forest & wilderness tour –the Scenic world with 52 degree inclined train ride deep down the valley with other two rides-cable ride & sky walk (multiple times), also walk to the echo point & exchange dialogues with the nature & educate about the aboriginal ages.
	Overnight stay at hotel in <b>Sydney</b> .
	MEALS: Continental Breakfast, Lunch & Indian Dinner
Day 15	<b>Departure</b>
	After breakfast at the hotel, check-out and transfer to airport for departure back home as the tour ends.
